**Show Dates:** The Cayuga County Fair will begin on Thursday, July 3, 2008 and all farms are welcome to check in for the start of the Fair which will open at noon. All alpacas **must** be checked by Friday, July 4, 2008 at 7:00 p.m. (or by pre-approval of the Show Coordinator). Check out will be Sunday, July 6, 2008 after 5 p.m. The Central NY Alpaca Classic will be an AOBA certified Show and will follow all AOBA Show Division rules. It is anticipated that this will be a Level II show.

**Venue:** The Central NY Alpaca Classic will once again be held under several large tents at the Cayuga County Fairgrounds on Route 31 in Weedsport, NY. Electricity and pens will be provided.

**Health Regulations:** Alpacas must have a CVI signed by an accredited Veterinarian and it will be required to be presented to show personnel and/or NYS Vet upon entrance/request. Alpacas must be microchipped and the alpaca's name and microchip number must appear on the CVI. Alpacas within NYS must test negative for tuberculosis by means of an axillary TB test within 12 months of the fair OR originate from a herd which has a valid certificate for a negative herd test. All alpacas must test PCR or VI negative for BVD **and** noted on the CVI. Health papers must be dated within 30 days of the close of the show.

Alpacas from outside NYS must meet all NYS importation regulations including BVD testing. The interstate CVI must be dated within 30 days of the close of the show. Out of state requirement questions should be directed to the Division of Animal Industry at 518-457-3971.

**Registration:** Entry forms are provided or available on the Cayuga County Fair website. All forms must be accompanied by a copy of each alpaca's ARI registration papers (no pending registrations can be accepted), payment in full, and postmarked no later than **June 10, 2008**. No entries will be accepted without payment in full. Late entries will be charged an additional \$10 late fee. No registrations will be accepted after June 30, 2008. Exhibitors must be the registered owners or provide a signed Buyer's Permission to Show form (which is available at [www.alpacashows.com](http://www.alpacashows.com)).

**Substitutions:** Substitutions will **only** be allowed upon the written consent of the Show Superintendent in advance of the show.

**Exhibitor Fees:** The entry fee is \$25 per alpaca (which includes a \$6 AOBA fee). Under AOBA Show Rules any non-AOBA Show Division member must pay \$75 per farm. As this show is being run under the rules of the AOBA Show Division, exhibitors are reminded that violations of ethics relating to all show participants may result in immediate expulsion from the show venue by Show Management and Show Management is then required to file an official protest.

**Stall Fees:** Each animal stall will be 8x8 at a cost of \$50 per stall and can house up to two alpacas. Limit will be 5 stalls per farm which includes a farm display stall. Display stalls will also be \$50 and displays will be limited to 6 feet high so as not to block airflow through the tents. Exhibitors are encouraged to provide alpaca educational materials for the public and selling of alpaca-related items will be permitted in your display stall.
