2. **ENTRIES:** Mail all entries for this department to the Superintendent. (SHEEP ONLY). If entering other departments, submit separate entry forms. Copies of the entries are acceptable. All payments must accompany the entry form.
3. **NO BEDDING WILL BE SUPPLIED BY THE FAIR.**
4. **ENTRY FEES:** \$.80 per entry, per class. This is 10% of top premium offered. Make check or money order payable to: CAYUGA COUNTY FAIR. **DO NOT SEND CASH!**
5. **EXHIBITOR FEE:** \$8.00 All persons entering animals in any competitive department must include an \$8.00 exhibitors fee with their entry.
6. **GENERAL RULES:** All of the NYS Department of Agriculture and Markets rules are in effect.
7. All show animals must meet USDA guidelines regarding the scrapie program.
8. **SHOW RULES:** Health and Registration papers must be presented to the Superintendent upon arrival on the grounds.
9. Sheep may arrive anytime after 5:30 pm on Wednesday July 7th, and must be in place by 12:00 noon on Thursday July 8th. Open show begins at 10:00 am on Friday, July 9th. Dismissal from the grounds will be no earlier than 4:00pm on Sunday July 11th. Earlier departure will result in forfeiture of premium payments.
10. Any animal in any class must be worthy of recognition or it will be eliminated from from competition.
11. Exhibitor's may enter and show as many entries as they wish in each class but may not receive more then 2 premiums in each class. In group exhibits, 1 premium per exhibitor.
12. The **REGISTRATION NUMBERS** will be required on all entries at the time of judging. Exhibitors must produce certificate of registry for all entries, and if

transferred, have them officially recorded in the breed association records.

13. The management assumes no responsibility in case of loss or damage to livestock or other exhibits from any cause. (Upon this condition only entries received).
